Mazda Part Number Format – Quick Guide

Mazda's part number is formatted as shown below. Dashes are shown when the part number must be read by humans. Dashes are **NOT** included in EDI data or bar codes.

If the part has a blank revision (engineering) level, but also has a color code, it MUST have a blank in the 10th position. Also, if there is no value in positions 10, 11, or 12, of the part number then spaces must be inserted for bar code and check digit creation.
